General Power of Attorney

GENERAL POWER OF ATTORNEY

I, VERNON H. MELVIN, hereby appoint JEAN L. MELVIN as my agent and attorney-in-fact ("Agent"). If she is unable or unwilling to serve, or to continue to serve, I appoint my son, GREGORY VERN MELVIN, as substitute or successor Agent, with all of the powers herein given to my Agent.

I give to my Agent the power of authority:

1. Support. To make expenditures for my health, care, maintenance, support and general welfare and for the health, maintenance and support of my wife.
2. Property Management. To take possession of, manage, administer, operate, maintain, improve and control all my property; to insure and keep the same insured; and to pay any and all taxes, charges and assessments that may be levied or imposed upon any such property.
3. Collections. To collect and receive any money, property, debts or claims that are now or shall in the future become due, owing and payable to me, and to give receipts or other sufficient discharges for any of the same.
4. Investments. To retain any property that comes into your possession in the form in which it was received and to make investments and changes of investments in such securities, including common and preferred stocks of corporations, or other property, real or personal, as you may determine to be prudent.
5. Checks and Notes. To sign, endorse, sell, discount, deliver or deposit checks, drafts, notes and negotiable and nonnegotiable instruments, and to accept drafts.
6. Debts. To pay my debts and other obligations.
7. Litigation. To sue upon, defend, compromise, submit to arbitration or adjust any controversies in which I may be

interested and to act in my name with respect to any complaints, proceedings or suits, with all the powers I would possess if personally present and under no legal disability.

8. Purchase of Property. To negotiate for, purchase and deal in property of every description.

9. Disposition of Property. To sell, convey, exchange, mortgage, pledge, consign, lease and in any other manner deal in and with my property.

10. Borrowing. To advance or loan your own funds on my behalf and to borrow any sums of money on such terms and at such rate of interest as you may consider proper and to give security for repayment of the same.

11. Agreements. To make and deliver any conveyances, contracts, covenants, undertakings or agreements, either orally or in writing, that you may determine to be for my best interest.

12. Voting Stock. To appear and vote for me in person or by proxy at any corporate or other meeting.

13. Safe Deposit Box. To have access to any safe deposit box which has been rented in my name or in the name of myself and any other person or persons.

14. Withdrawal of Funds. To withdraw any funds held or deposited in any money market account, agency account or brokerage account established by me, or otherwise deposited with any bank, mutual savings bank, savings and loan association, or other financial institution, in my name or in the name of myself and any other person or persons, and generally to do any business with any such financial institution on my behalf.

15. Tax Returns. To sign and file on my behalf all state and federal income, gift or other tax returns or reports; to receive and endorse all checks in payment of a refund of any such taxes; to execute waivers, extension agreements and closing agreements with respect to those returns; and to appear for me, in person or by an attorney, before the United States Treasury Department, the Oregon Department of Revenue or the taxing authority of any other governmental entity.

16. Government Benefits. To do and perform every act necessary or desirable, including serving as a representative payee, with respect to rights and entitlement for my benefit

from Social Security, Medicare, the Department of Veteran Affairs, and other governmental agencies and departments.


17. Gifts. To make gifts of cash or other property, outright or in trust, to my children and grandchildren in amounts which you determine to be within the annual exclusions available for federal gift tax purposes.

18. Delegation. To appoint any nominee for any or all of the purposes set forth above, and to revoke such appointment at any time.

I authorize you as my Agent to do and perform for me and in my name all and every act which is necessary or desirable to be done in order to properly conduct, manage and control all my business and property and to execute and acknowledge any and all instruments necessary or proper to carry out the foregoing powers, hereby releasing all third persons from responsibility for the acts and omissions of my Agent.

I am familiar with the provisions of ORS 127.005 and I understand that the powers of my Agent described above shall be exercisable by my Agent on my behalf even though I may become legally disabled or incompetent.
